# Entry Guidelines

## Entry requirements

None (entrants under 20 years old must get permission from their parent or guardian)

## Entry limit

Maximum of 3 photographs per entrant

## Entry method

Entries will be accepted by email (aichi40@cbc-creation.co.jp) in JPEG format only.

As selected entries will be printed and displayed, photographs should be high quality (around 5MB).

Photos will be displayed in A4 size.

## Entry procedure

- 1 Create an email with the subject "40th Anniversary Photo Contest Submission."
- 2 In the body of the email, enter the following information. If you are submitting multiple entries, please provide a title and comment for each one.

- a. Name
- b. Address
- c. Email address
- d. Photo title
- e. Where and when the photo was taken
- f. Comment (short description of or story relating to the photo)

- 3 Attach your photos to the email.
- 4 Send the email (aichi40@cbc-creation.co.jp).

- Submissions must be previously unpublished original works. Photos that are not in line with the spirit of the conservation of nature or public order will be excluded from consideration. Altered photos will also be disqualified.
- Please verify that your photos do not have any copyright issues (i.e. other photos, characters) and that you have not violated the image rights of any person who appears in your photos. The Aichi Prefectural Government (APG) will not engage in any dispute that might arise from this type of issue and cedes all responsibility to the entrant.
- Entrants must comply with the APG's operation policies and must not raise any objections to those policies.
- The APG reserves the right to change the exhibition venue and period.
- Responses to questions about the judging process will not be provided under any circumstances.
- Any personal information (name, address, etc.) provided by entrants will be used exclusively for the purpose of this contest.
- The content of the event is subject to change.
